## Local Road Safety Program (LRSP)

- Prepared as part of North Dakota's statewide safety planning process
- Data driven process with a goal to reduce severe crashes
- Documents at-risk locations
- Identifies effective low-cost safety improvement strategies
- Positions the counties to compete for available safety funds
- Provides a tool to assist counties in submitting safety projects



## Typical LRSP Includes:

- Description of safety emphasis areas
- Identifies list of high-priority, low-cost Safety Strategies
- Documents at-risk locations along county/local road systems
- Development of suggested county-wide safety projects
- Discussion of behavioral crash statistics, potential safety strategies, and current resources available for implementation of behavioral strategies

# How to apply for LRSP funding?

Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP)

Annual Solicitation by early October

Application Deadline **December 31**



## LRSP Project Applications

- SFN 59959 HSIP project application is already filled out
- Each application is considered a preapproved eligible project
- County selects pages from LRSP plan for HSIP projects
- Submits forms to NDDOT during the solicitation process
- NDDOT committed to assist with funding for LRSP projects

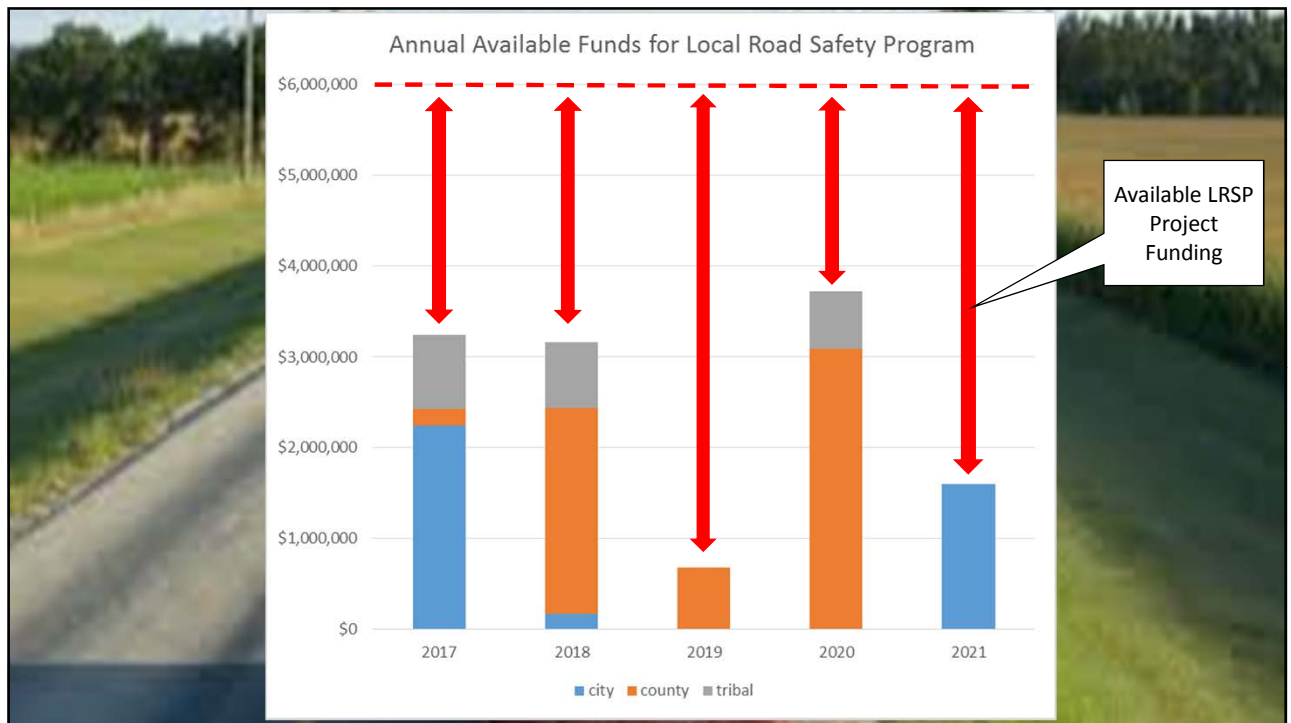
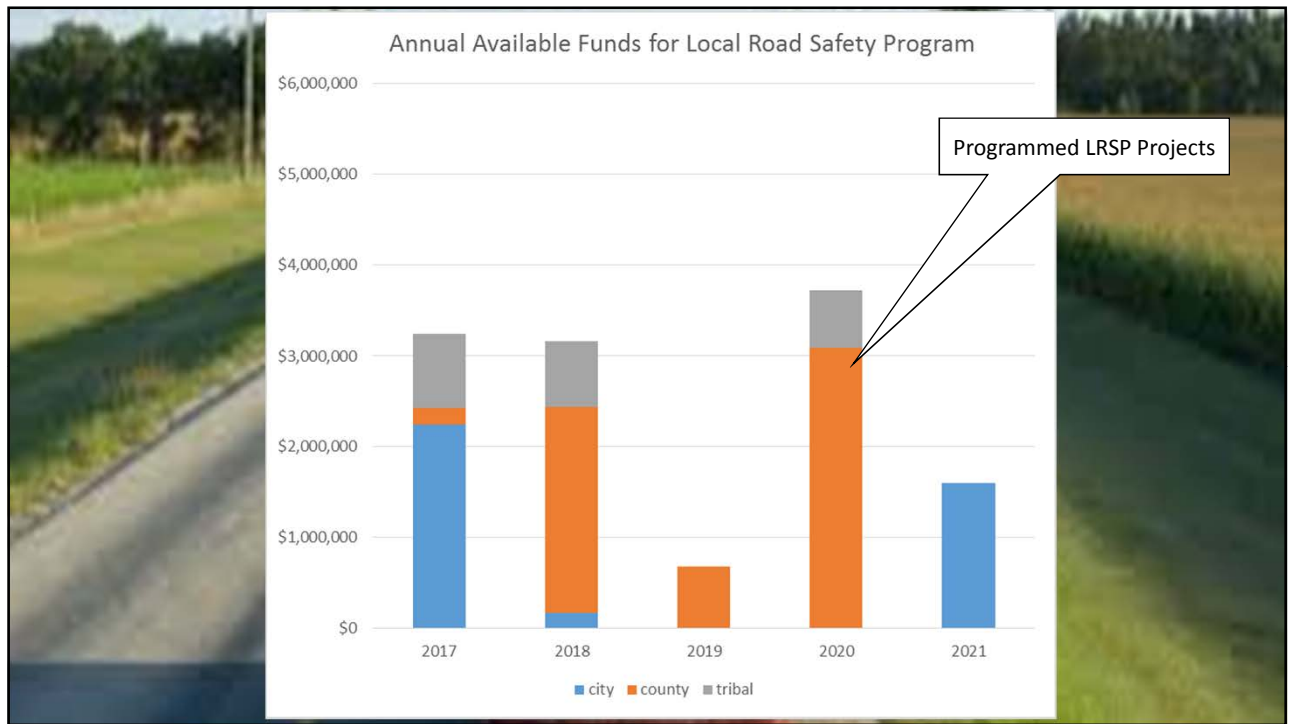
