
- Mission: Eliminate fatalities and serious injuries on North Dakota roadways.



# WESTERN NORTH DAKOTA PROJECTS

• HB 1012 | Funding to complete US 85 Four Lane Project

The department of transportation shall develop a plan to complete the United States highway 85 four-lane project in its entirety as approved in the final environmental impact statement document for project number 9-085(085)075, PCN20046.

Work on the plan has started.
 Plan is due August 1, 2024.



## MARLEY CROSSING | GRANT APPLICATIONS

### FY'22 RAISE Planning Grant | Submitted in April 2022; not awarded

- Grade Separation NEPA work at the BNSF Marley Crossing; Corridor Study of ND 1804 (ND 58 to US 2 - excluding the US 2 intersection)
- Cost Estimate: \$3.6M total, all grant

#### FY'23 RAISE Planning Grant | Submitted in Feb. 2023; not awarded

- Grade Separation NEPA and Final Design work at BNSF Marley Crossing; Corridor Study of ND 1804 (ND 58 to US 2 - excluding the US 2 intersection)
- Cost Estimate: \$4.8M total; \$2.4M grant; \$0.5M federal formula; \$1.9M State

## FY'24 RAISE Planning Grant | Submitted in Feb. 2024; awards not yet announced

- Grade separation NEPA work at the BNSF Marley Crossing
- BNSF prepared this application; NDDOT submitted it
- Cost Estimate: \$2.4M total; \$1.92M grant; \$0.24M State; \$0.24M BNSF





## TRIBAL SAFETY PROJECTS

#### FORT BERTHOLD | Tribal Safety Grant

- Intersection of ND 23 and ND 22 installation of a roundabout *Nearly complete*
- ND 23 east of New Town turn lanes and lighting Nearly complete
- ND 23B (New Town NE Truck Reliever Route) signing and rumble strips *Complete*
- ND 23 west of 4-Bears Casino turn lanes and lighting Complete
- ND 73 reconstruction of remaining 5.5 miles which includes passing lanes and a roundabout at the junction of ND 22 *Under construction*

#### OTHER PROJECTS

Highway Safety Corridor from ND 22 from Jct of 73 to 23. (Coming in 2025)

# REDUCED CONFLICT INTERSECTIONS (RCIs)

- 3 RCIs are being built on US 2 between US 85 & ND 1804 west of Williston.
- The NDDOT completed a safety review that highlighted the need.
- The RCIs are scheduled to be completed by the end of this construction season.
