National Schemes

- NHVAS (National Heavy Vehicle Accreditation Scheme)
 - Vehicles over 12 tonne GVM NOT COMPULSORY
- Trucksafe commenced before NHVAS was Nationally rolled out (was being "tested" in Victoria)- NOT COMPULSORY
- Main Roads Western Australian Scheme Operated by Main Roads Western Australia (MRWA) as WA <u>are not</u> in the National Scheme – COMPULSORY in WA



NHVAS (National Heavy Vehicle Accreditation Scheme)

- Operated by the National Heavy Vehicle Regulator (NHVR) this is run by the Federal Government and individual states have put in place complementary Acts of each Parliament to bring it into operation in their jurisdictions – WA & NT have not accepted
- An experienced Auditor rates the NHVR Scheme as 8/10 and the associated processes as 6/10



Trucksafe

- A scheme operated by the Australian Trucking Association (ATA) and originally designed to also create a revenue for the Member Associations.
- Auditors at 'arms length' as paid by Trucksafe, not the business being audited
- Accepted by authorities as it uses the NHVR Standards of Mass, Maintenance and Basic Fatigue
- An experienced Auditor rates the Trucksafe Scheme as 5/10 and the associated processes as 7/10
- Trucksafe also includes modules for:
 - Management Training; On road compliance; Fitness for Duty & Driver Health

Main Roads WA Scheme

- Operated by Main Roads Western Australia (MRWA) as WA are not in the National Scheme
- Compulsory for all Commercial Vehicles operating at over 4.5 tonne gross mass that operate in Western Australia even if based in other states.
- An experienced Auditor rates the MRWA Scheme as 8/10 and the associated processes as 6/10



Auditors – enforcers or educators?

- Have to be accredited through Exemplar Global for all schemes
- NHVAS auditors also separately registered with scopes noted. Fatigue noted separately for those able to cover this
- Auditors <u>can be anyone</u> that completes the 'on line exams' (open book exams), used to have to also be ISO 9001 accredited



Auditors – enforcers or educators?

- No restrictions based on industry experience (or lack of)
- Around 100 auditors across Australia
- About 10% have useful industry experience, many are regulators who have been made redundant and then establish a 'tick a box' paperwork based audit system – audits conducted over the phone or even online
- Auditor shopping' can be an issue find someone who will give you the ticks you need
